Starting today, April 11, students have the opportunity to participate in our fourth year with the program **Bikes for Books**. This is a statewide program sponsored by the **Grand Lodge of Masons in Maine and the Maine Masonic Charitable Foundation**. It is intended to foster literacy programs in local schools and encourage healthy exercise.

The Bikes for Books process is quite simple. Today we had a kick-off assembly where the program was introduced to students. Students can fill out a book slip each time they read a book. The slips will also be available for them to fill out here at school. They will place the slips into a box that will be housed in their classroom. We will collect slips until Monday, June 10.

During the week of June 10, we will have a second assembly and two names will be drawn from each classroom to win a bike, helmet and t-shirt.
