It is likely that we will have a “sold out” show each evening, as it is a very popular event. Here is how our ticket distribution works:

- Each student will have a total of **six (6) tickets** to divide between the two nights. **Please note: All of our K-3 students will have seen the dress rehearsal during school hours. You may want to consider using your tickets for adults, rather than those WES siblings who have already seen the show.**
- You will not be charged for tickets.
- Tickets are reserved by phone, **beginning Tuesday, May 22rd, between 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 pm. Please call the office at 646-5953. Tickets will be mailed to you. When you call to request your tickets:**
- **You must designate how you would like your tickets divided for the two nights.** It is a great support to your child to have a family member present each night, if possible. *While we do our very best to accommodate all families’ wishes with respect to how their tickets will be divided, please understand that there is a **strict** seating capacity in the room, which may limit some of these choices. Thank you in advance for your understanding and flexibility.*
- *Please let us know if you will **not** be needing all of your tickets, so that we may offer the extras to other families.*
- *Extra tickets may be requested on a first-call, first-served basis.*

Doors to the school will open at 6:15 pm. Please have your entire party in line with you while waiting to enter, and **do not save spaces or seats for those not present**, as this is an important event for *all* of our families. People with mobility issues (i.e. handicapped or elderly), will have special accommodations as follows:

- Limited handicapped parking will be available. *“Reserved Seating” will be available to those families who have handicapped or elderly members with mobility issues. Requests for handicapped seating **must be made when you call for your tickets.*** We know you will enjoy this wonderful performance. Thank you for your support.
